Community Resource Guide

Additionally, Chaplain Needham had sent an electronic version to Supervisor Fleming so that it could be posted on the Town's website.

• Gift Vouchers for Police

At the committee's previous meeting Officer Jones indicated that it would be helpful to have vouchers that transient and other impoverished persons could be given by the police for food and beverage. The Committee had asked both Stewarts and Cumberland Farms corporate offices for donations for this purpose. The Committee's request did not meet Stewart's guidelines for donations, but Cumberland Farms donated ten \$10 gift coupons which were given to Office Resfife. Chaplain Needham asked that the police track the distribution of these so that the committee can gain a sense of frequency and need.

The Committee has also sent a thank you letter to Cumberland Farms.

Presentation

The Committee selected April 4th, 2019 at Chandler Young Veteran's Association to hold its meeting on homelessness and persons in need. Kevin O'Connor, Executive Director of Joseph's House will deliver a presentation on homelessness in Rensselaer County. The Committee also discussed the idea that we would speak about local issues such as the good work of the Gathering Place and the Resource Center, as well as the goals of the Committee.
