- Reviewed Previous Meeting Minutes
 - With few editorial revisions the minutes were finalized and approved by the committee and will be sent out to the distribution list.
- Reminder for brief biographies for committee members to put on website.
- Chaplain Needham is working on getting the Committee business cards with information so that contacts can be made and information passed along.
 - Will include our logo, the 501 (C)(3) designation, “People Helping People”, as well as our webpage and Facebook addresses.
- Also working on getting “Donate Now” or “Click to Donate” links on the website and Facebook pages so people can contribute to the organization. Language will be added to the sites providing examples of how the monies donated might be used by the organization.
- Chaplain Needham also indicated that he met with Melanie Fuss with the Commission on Economic Opportunity about potential collaborations. They have under utilized programs / facilities and we hope she will be getting involved with Nassau Resource Committee.
- Chaplain Needham also passed along information about a potential family in need who have reportedly been living in a small camp between two houses along County Route 15 – and that there might be a need for services. He is working to get additional information.
- Zoom Informational Presentation
 - Chaplain Needham reached out to Diana Harvey of Nassau County (Long Island) regarding a zoom presentation focused on domestic violence prevention and helpful tips for dealing with stress.
